**Flexible learning** possibilities (just-for-you, just-enough, just-in-time) based on ICT technologies.

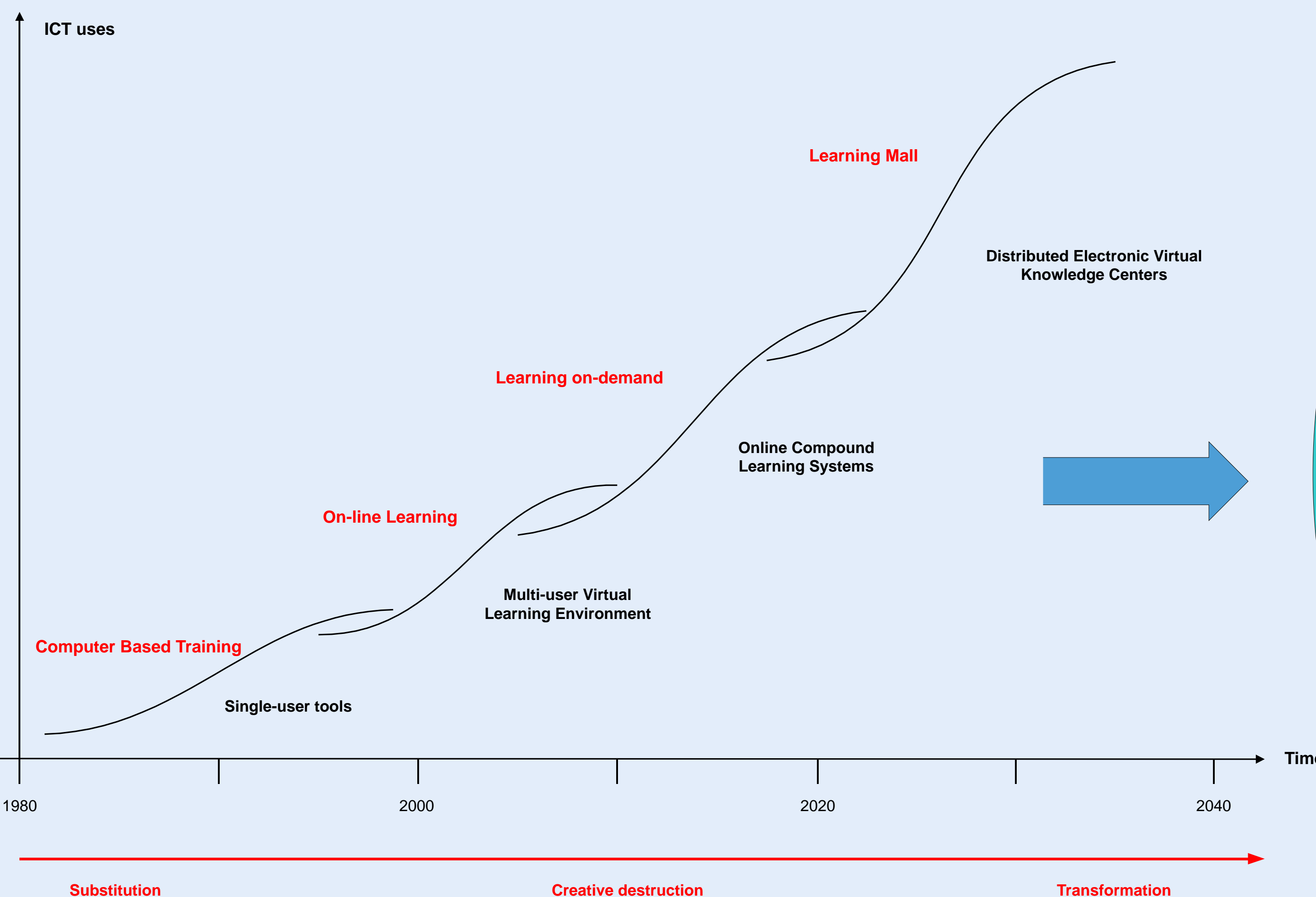

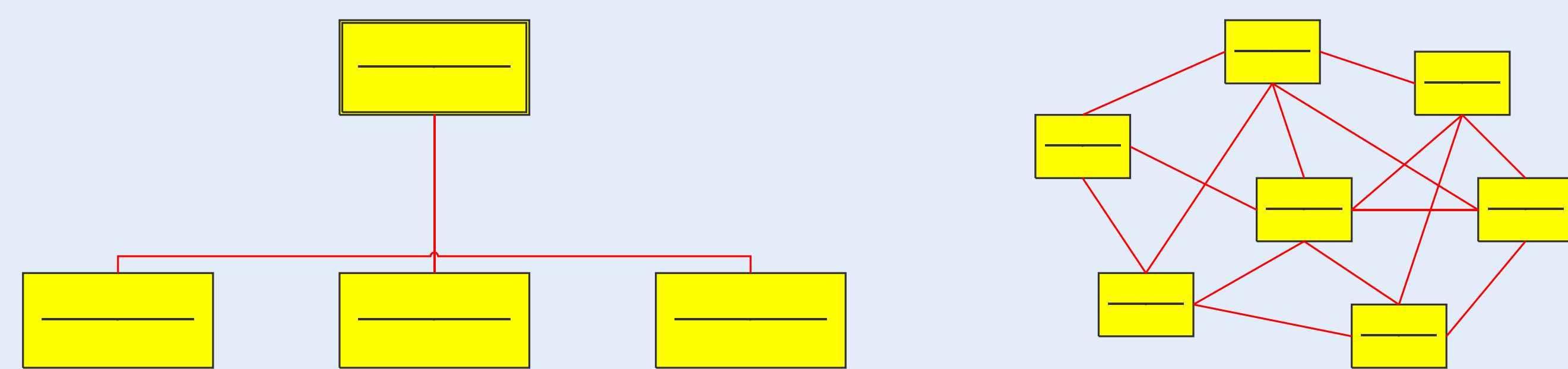
## Technology

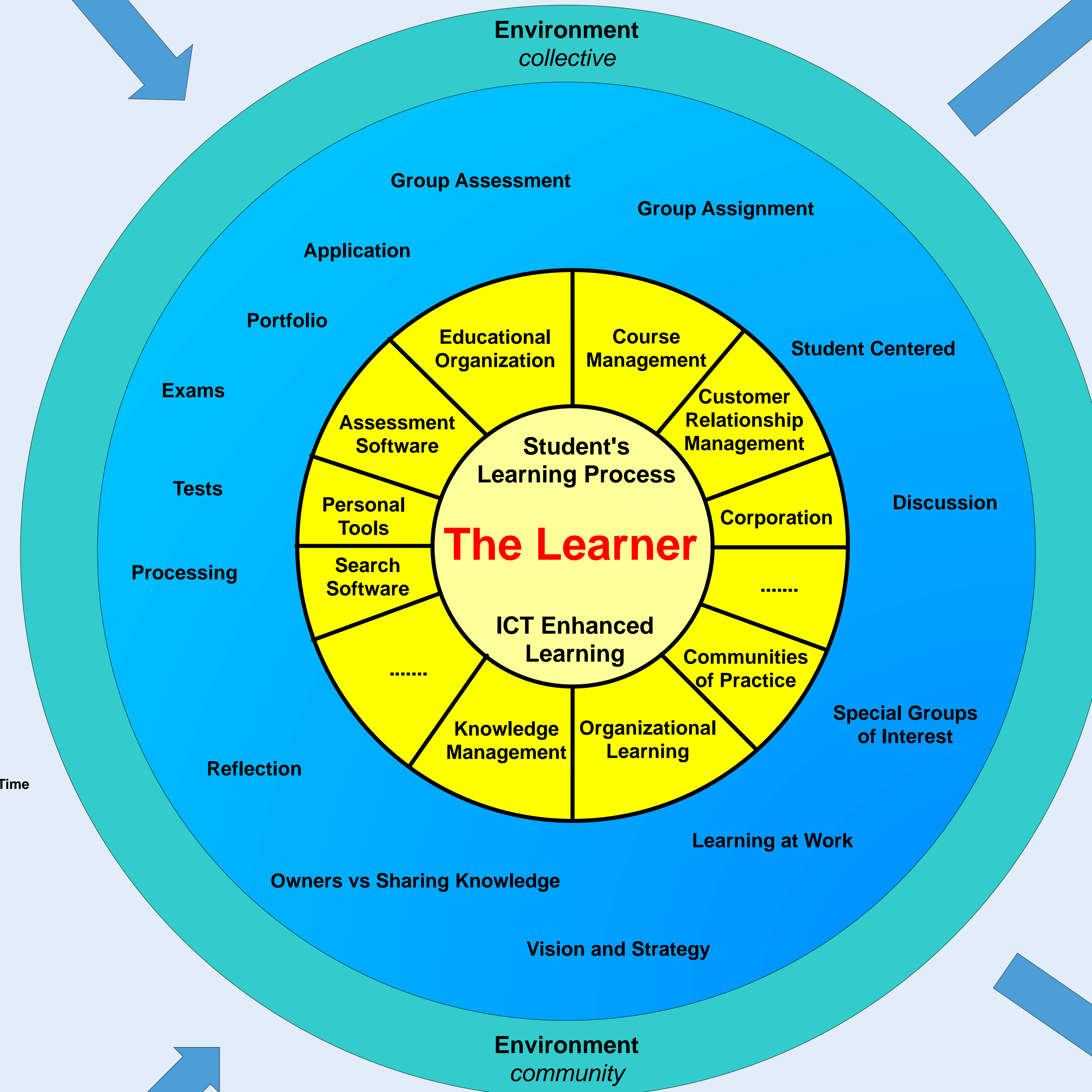
Transformation from information-based hierachical settings to knowledge-based networking communities.

Internet-based business and supporting systems replace the participant-owned legacy systems. Number of administrator and supporting staff is diminishing accordingly.

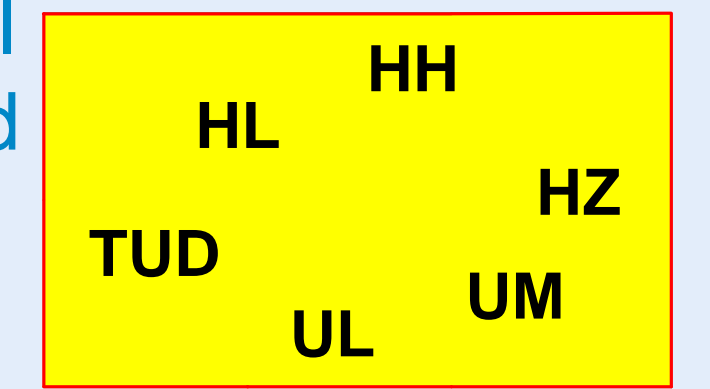

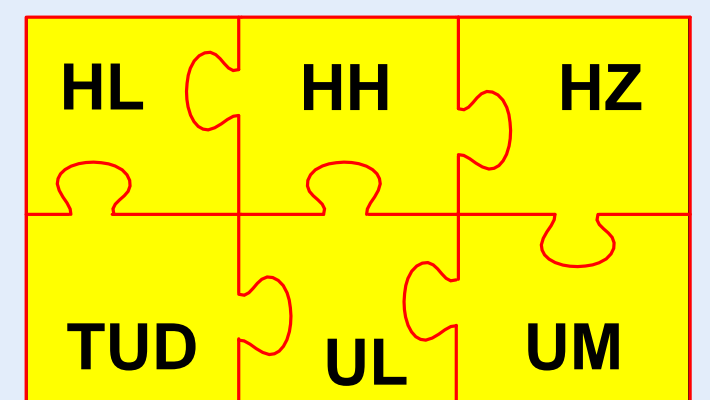
## Innovator

The consortium is a new educational institute. Educational programs are completely merged and mainly based on enhanced ICT technologies. Students only register at consortium level. The participants act together.



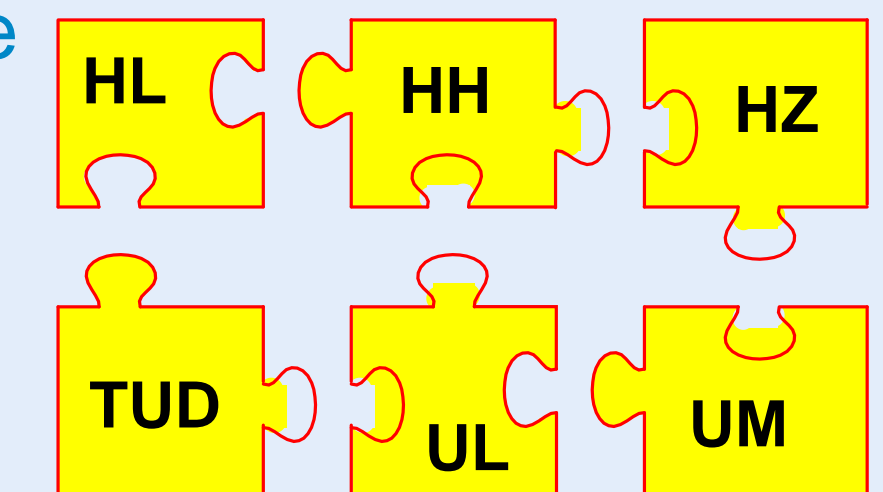
## Marketeer

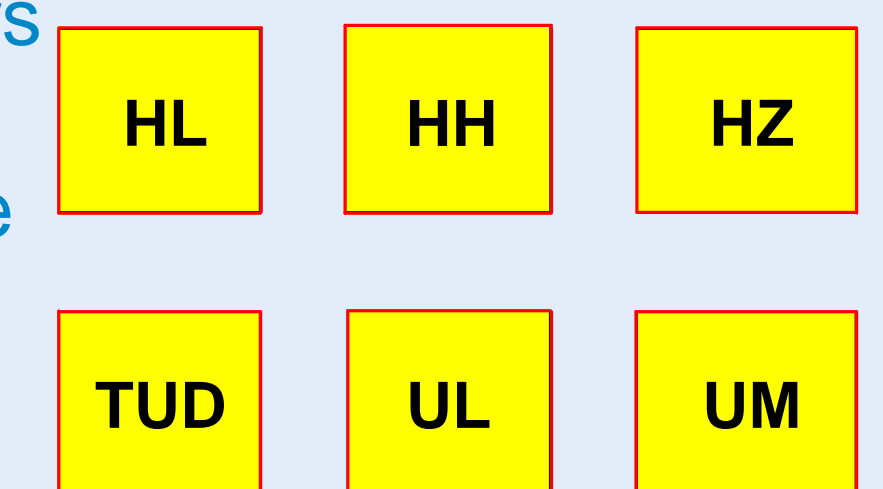
## Renewer
